Revision to Applications for Free and Reduced Price Meals

For the first time in several years, USDA has issued major prototype revisions for the Applications for Free and Reduced Price Meals, directions for households, and the parent/household letters. The prototypes have been adapted for use in Indiana and are located on the CACFP web page (http://www.doe.in.gov/food/childadults/welcome.html) in the section, Free and Reduced Price Information.

CACFP participating institutions (center-types, homes, and adult day care) are required to begin using the forms effective **July 1, 2011**.

You will note the Applications for Free and Reduced Price Meals (child care and adult) contain the current income guidelines. This document will be updated each fiscal year. The parent/household letters do not have information that must be updated each year, so changes will only be made as regulations and policies change.
